About the Geneva Lions Club Scholarship

The Geneva Lions Club Scholarship is awarded to graduating high school seniors attending high school within the Geneva Lions Club service area of Geneva and St. Charles, **Geneva High School**, **St. Charles-East and St. Charles-North**. As an organization dedicated to service in these communities for over 87 years, the scholarships are designed *to reward and promote a commitment to "service*." Therefore, the <u>community service component</u> is heavily weighted. Additional criteria include:

- Graduating senior attending one of the 3 Geneva or St. Charles high schools of Geneva High School, St. Charles-East or St. Charles-North.
- Will attend a 4 or 2-year college or trade school, starting no later than the fall semester following high school graduation
- Achieved a GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or 4.0 on a 5.0 scale (a B average)
